

<b>Time of Presidency:</b> 1921-1923	<b>Party:</b> Republican	<b>President #:</b> 29	<b>Warren G. Harding</b>

- America at this time**
- Campaign revolved around the support of the League of Nations, which Harding did not support
  - Harding conducted a front-porch campaign

- Domestic Policy**
- Scandals plagued Harding's presidency, including the famed Teapot Dome scandal, involving oil interests and federal involvement
  - Copper-Volstead act allows for group purchasing of farm equipment for farmers

- Foreign Policy**
- Immigration restricted to 3% of nationality population with the Dillingham Immigration Act of 1921
  - Naval fleets disarmed under Washington Disarmament Conference
  - Two tariff bills passed, causing economic uncertainty
